This is an accessibility statement from Alberta Ability Network.

Measures to support accessibility

Alberta Ability Network takes the following measures to ensure accessibility of Alberta Ability Network:

- Include accessibility as part of our mission statement.
- Include accessibility throughout our internal policies.
- Integrate accessibility into our procurement practices.
- Appoint an accessibility officer and/or ombudsperson.
- Provide continual accessibility training for our staff.
- Assign clear accessibility goals and responsibilities.
- Employ formal accessibility quality assurance methods.
- Alberta Ability Network recognizes that access to information and communication technologies is a basic human right. We ensure that website content is accessible to all and is compatible with all devices, communicators need for accessibility.

Conformance status

The [Web Content Accessibility Guidelines \(WCAG\)](#) defines requirements for designers and developers to improve accessibility for people with disabilities. It defines three levels of conformance: Level A, Level AA, and Level AAA. Alberta Ability Network is partially conformant with WCAG 2.1 level AA. Partially conformant means that some parts of the content do not fully conform to the accessibility standard.

Additional accessibility considerations

Link text, text in images, use of color & contrast, zoomed content.

Media Alternatives

All audio files, videos and GIFs have text alternatives, enabling people with vision impairments or hearing loss to access them.

- Audio files: Added text transcript of what you can hear
- Videos without sound, or GIFs: Added text description of what you can see
- Videos with sound: Added captions that explain what you can see and hear, and the context
